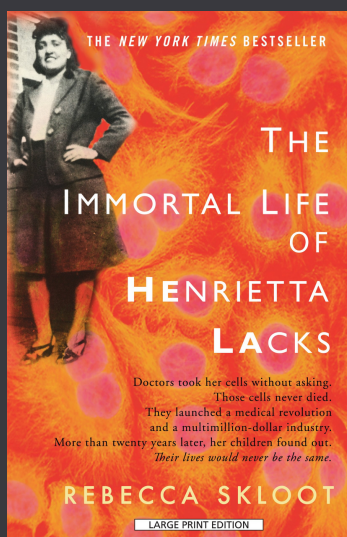

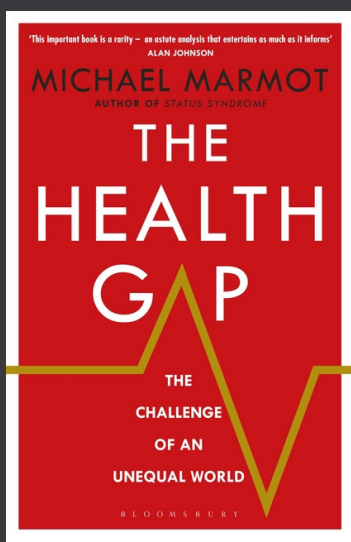
THE IMMORTAL LIFE OF HENRIETTA LACKS

The fates of undocumented families are like a roller-coaster as the United States' immigration policies are transformed.



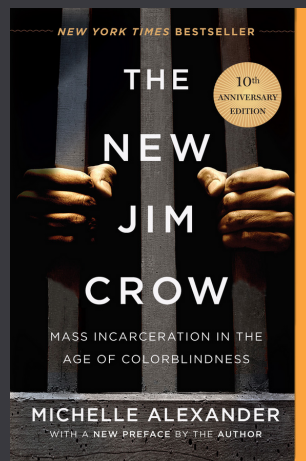
SUCH A FUN AGE

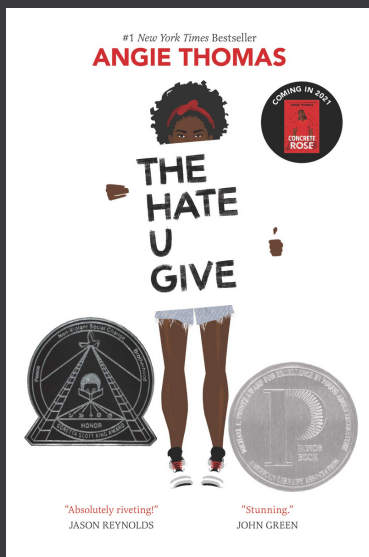
THE VANISHING HALF

-Novel By Angie Thomas
Starr Carter is constantly switching between two worlds -- the poor, mostly black neighborhood where she lives and the wealthy, mostly white prep school that she attends. The uneasy balance between these worlds is soon shattered when she witnesses the fatal shooting of her childhood best friend at the hands of a police officer. Facing pressure from all sides of the community, Starr must find her voice and decide to stand up for what's right.



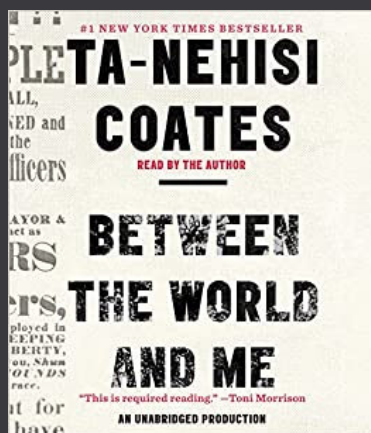
SO YOU WANT TO TALK ABOUT RACE

A race and culture outlet and a weekly podcast from American public radio network NPR.

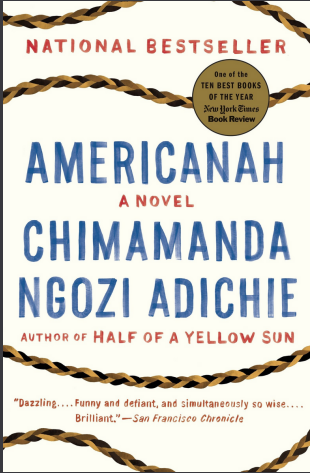
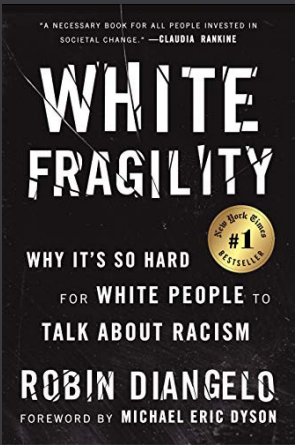

In this in-depth exploration, DiAngelo examines how white fragility develops, how it protects racial inequality, and what we can do to engage more constructively.

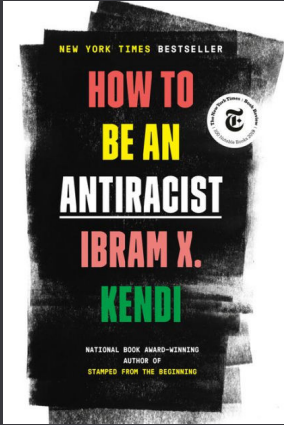
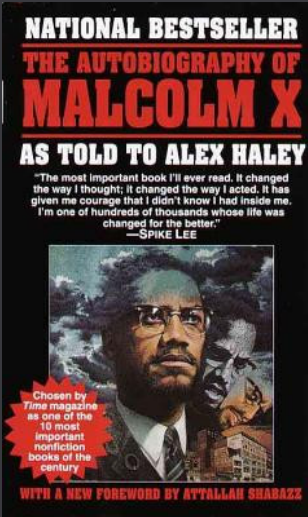


AMERICANAH

WHITE PRIVILEGE: UNPACKING THE INVISIBLE KNAPSACK

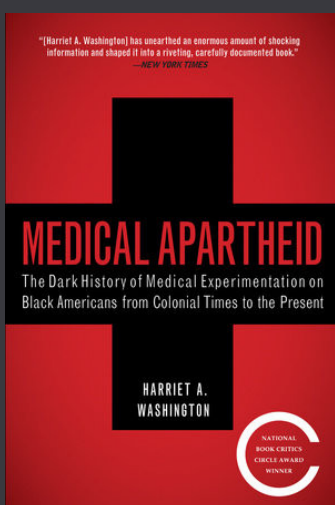
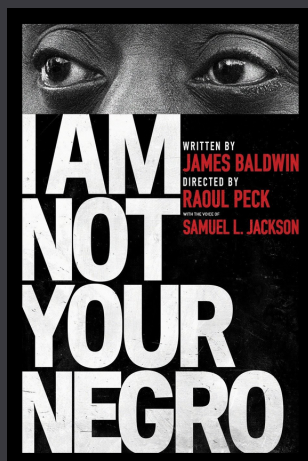
-Essay By Peggy McIntosh

Based on the life of James Baldwin-In 1979, James Baldwin wrote a letter to his literary agent describing his next project, "Remember This House."

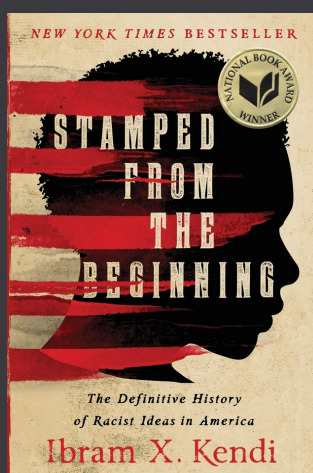


MEDICAL APARTHEID

A deep look at the state of U.S. immigration, utilizing unprecedented access to ICE operations and moving portraits of immigrants.

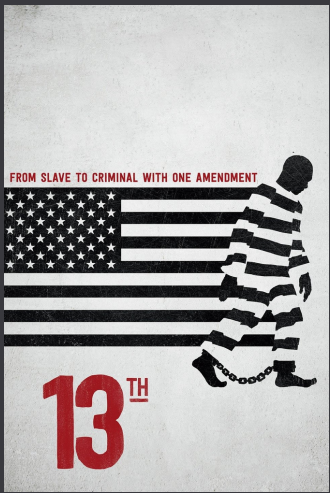

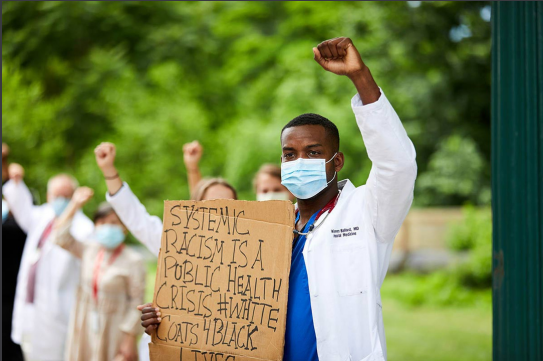
WHEN THEY SEE US
